Judging

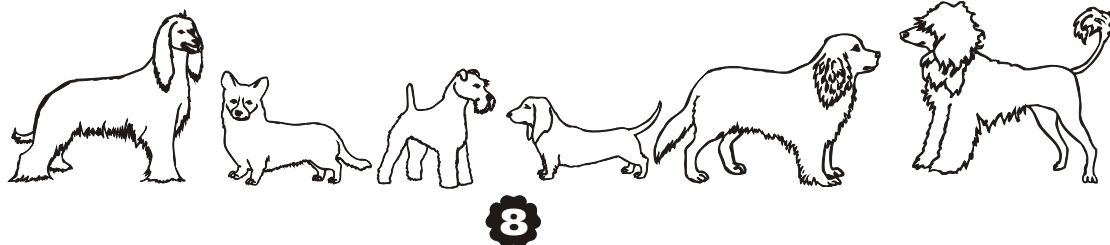

Remittance: Must be made to Hon. Secretary, in the name of “**NAGPUR CANNINE CLUB**”, payable at **NAGPUR**. The remittance must be made either in Cash or Demand Draft only. No refund will be given on cancellation of any entry. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees in full.

Paid Kennels: Paid kennels are available on the show ground exclusively for your dogs on payment of Rs.500/-. Your Payment and request should accompany the entry form. Stalls are Prepared only on Advance Booking.

K.C.I. Rules & Regulations For Shows

Eligibility: Only dog Registered with the “KENNEL CLUB OF INDIA” may compete. Please see regulation no. 3 or the K.C.I. regulation for the show. CRYPTORCHID / MONORCHID DOGS will not be allowed to compete. No. RAF entries shall be accepted.

Caution: The committee reserves the right to exclude any entry it may think fit to exclude. Exhibitors should make themselves familiar with the K.C.I. Rules & Regulations for Shows, which may be obtained from the Hon. Secretary. K.C.I.. Exhibitors are cautioned that an entry in the Wrong Class or Breed will disqualify the exhibit.

Enforcement & Amendment of Rules: The decision of the Show Committee is final, subject only to appeal to K.C.I. Should questions arise which are not provided for in the rules, Committee’s decision will be final.

Judges: Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling his/her engagements, or should the entries exceed more than the judging capacity of the single judge. Additional judges as per the K.C.I. rules will be requisitioned while keeping the Pointed show status rules of the KCI. Any such changes will be informed to exhibitors as and when they are made. The Committee reserves itself, the right of appointing another judge in his or her place. No objections will be entertained.

Ring Stewards: All the Ring Stewards are KCI licensed, any discipline by the exhibitor will attract appropriate action, on the Ring Stewards recommendations, as per KCI rules.

Veterinary Examination: All Dogs must be Passed by the Hon. Veterinary Surgeon present at the gate and the Certified Fit by him before admission.

Note: All exhibitors should carry the certificate with him & present it to the waiting ring steward before entering the ring.

Penalty: All willful misrepresentation regarding ownership, age, name, pedigree, etc. of dogs entered and / or prepared for exhibition in contravention of the KCI Regulations, will be liable for disciplinary action by the committee.

Note: Dogs that are not present in the ring when their classes are judged will be deemed to have been absent.

Objections: Objections will be decided by the committee in accordance with the K.C.I. Regulations. The Objection Fee is Rs.1000/- returnable, if the objection is held valid by the Show Committee, forfeited, if turned down.

Challenge Certificates: Challenge & Reserve Challenge certificate will be awarded at the show. All Indian Breeds are eligible for C.C's & R.C.C.'s. Minor Puppy Dog / Bitch is not eligible for C.C's & R.C.C.'s.

Calculation of Age shall be Taken upto 11th February 2012.

Date of birth, K.C.I. Regn. No., Name, Sex, Name of Sire & Dam, Name of Breeder must be clearly written on the entry form for each dog. A dog imported from a broad shall not be eligible to be entered in more than 2 classes & bred in India class. All exhibits of unknown percentage & date of birth will not be allowed to compete for the Best Bred in India & Best Puppy of the Show Awards.

Best in show: With the introduction of the Group Judging, a maximum of only 17 dogs could be present for Best i show judging, which is as follows: Working Group-3, Gungdog Group-3, Hound Group-3, Toy Group-2, Terrier Group-2, Utility Group-2, Pastoral Group-2. These 17 dogs will be called in and placed in order of each separate group winnings. The Judge shall than chose the top 8 dogs.

Important Notice Issued by KCI for Exhibitors

- 1) Double Handling of any Breed is Banned. Violating Exhibit will be Removed from the Judging Ring by the Ring Steward.
- 2) To impose a Ban / Suspension on any Exhibitor / Handler found drunk while Exhibiting the dog in the show ring.
- 3) To impose a Ban / Suspension on any Exhibitor who is found to Argue with the Judge or Fight or use Abusive language against Co-Exhibitor or any Show Official will be Removed from the ring.
- 4) Violation of rule 2 & 3 will attract a Ban / Suspension for a minimum period of 2 years and also a fine of Rs. 1000/- and such persons shall not be permitted to Own. Register or Exhibit any dog at a K.C.I. Recognised show during the above period of Suspension. Exhibitors and dog Owners are cautioned to keep away from alcohol and visitors who are Drunk on the Show Ground to avoid punishments & suspensions. Dog Handlers are not allowed to display Kennel or Dog names in any form while showing the Dog in the ring.
- 5) Pursuant to the decision taken at the Annual General Meeting of the Kennel Club of India held not 24th September 2003, the Veteran Class has now been removed and there will be only six classes excluding the Champion Class. Henceforth it is mandatory that at the time of sending the entry, a Champion dog, irrespective of the fact, as to whether the owner has applied for the title of Championship or not should be entered only in the Champion class irrespective of its sex. Failure in doing so will amount in misrepresentation and the dog would be disqualified from the show automatically.
- 6) Pursuant to the decision taken at the Annual General Meeting of The Kennel Club of India, it has been decided to revert back to the old system of choosing the Best In Show Bred In India.

from amongst the lineup of the tope eight dogs chosen by the judge at the conclusion of the show.

- 7) Similarly for the selection of the Best Puppy, an exhibit is required to be entered in the Puppy class and all unbeaten puppies from the puppy class shall be called to compete for the Best Puppy in Show.
- 8) As per the new regulations, a runner-up to the B.O.B., Irrespective of sex will be chosen in place of B.O.S. For this purpose, the Champion Class is judged first and the 1st and its reserve, irrespective of sex are retained in the ring. Thereafter, the C.C. Dog and the Bitch are called in along with the first two dogs chosen in the Champions class for judging the B.O.B. Once the B.O.B. has been selected, the dog that is placed 2nd to the B.O.B. winner will automatically come into the ring for the selection of the runner up. The runner-up could be from the same sex or even the same class, as the B.O.B. Winner.
- 9) For Group Judging all the B.O.B. winners will be called in the ring and the runner-up to respective B.O.B. should be present in the waiting ring. Once the group winner is chosen, the reserve to the dog that has won the group should be compulsorily called in to compete for the 1st runner-up to the Group winner. Then the 2nd runner-up is chosen from the rest of the dogs. The runner-up could be from the same sex or even the same class, as the Group Winner.
- 10) Owner Will Be Responsible For Any Untoward/ Fatal Incident Or Any Mishap/ Theft Of The Dog. During The Show & Will Not Hold The Organizers Responsible For the Same.
